TACO METHOD





GROCERY SHOPPING STEP-BY-STEP

- TALK with children about Philippians 2:24 and go over the 3 expectations: TEAMWORK, HUMILITY/UNITY, COOPERATION
- 2. ASK question to create a shopping list. Children can choose their favorite snacks, dinner items, and ingredients.
- 3. CHRIST EXAMPLES. Your family trip is a living example for Jesus. Be patient. Be prayerful. If you get frustrated the first few times, don't give up. You are a living testimony for your children and community.
- 4. Give them OPPORTUNITIES to shop for everyone's needs, not their own. As you shop, give them tasks to complete, like finding shapes, animals, colors, and most cost-effective items.
